## Iraq overtakes Saudi Arabia as India's biggest Oil Supplier

- Iraq overtook Saudi Arabia to become India's top crude oil supplier by supplying 38.9 million tonnes (MT) crude oil in the current financial year. It was fifth of India's oil needs.
- India is 80% dependent on imports to meet its oil needs. India had imported 184.4 MT of crude oil during April. Saudi Arabia traditionally has been India's top oil source but Iraq dethroned it.
- Saudi Arabia supplied 30.9 MT of crude oil in first
   10 months.

# Indian Military Ranked 4th Strongest In World, USA Tops

 Out of 133 countries, India is ranked fourth on a global index for its military strength, only the United States, Russia and China are ranked above












- India on the list, according to the latest report of the Global Firepower index 2017.
- The Neighbouring Pakistan is ranked 13th.
- India maintained its position above France in the top five military powers in the world. The Indian Army is equipped with 4,426 combat tanks, 6,704 armored fighting vehicles, and 7,414 towed artillery guns, as per the list.
- The Top 5 countries in the list are 1. The USA, 2. Russia, 3. China, 4. India, 5. France.

# Washington Becomes First State to Enact Its Own Net Neutrality Rules

- Washington became the first state to pass a new law — House Bill 2282 — that restores and protects certain net neutrality rules, after the Federal Communications Commission voted 3–2 in favor of repealing net neutrality nationwide late last year.
- Washington state's new rules were signed into law by Governor Jay Inslee, and prevent internet service providers from blocking and slowing down content online.
- This will become nationwide law itself by April 23, 2018.







## UK college to teach Hinglish to students for jobs in India

- UK's Portsmouth College has offered to teach its students 'Hinglish', a mix of Hindi and English languages, becoming the country's first educational institution to do so.
- The course is being introduced partly due to India's growing economic importance and to prepare British students who may take up jobs in India or in Indian companies based in the UK.

# US President Donald Trump to meet North Korean leader Kim Jong un for 1st time by May

- President Donald Trump accepted an offer of a summit from the North Korean leader and will meet with Kim Jong Un by May, in a remarkable turnaround in relations between two historic adversaries. it would be the first time a sitting US president has met a North Korea leader.
- North Korea recently offered to denuclearise itself for a guarantee of security against military threats from the US.









# Angela Merkel Elected To 4th Term As German Chancellor

- Germany's Parliament elected Angela Merkel for her fourth term as chancellor, putting an end to nearly six months of political drift in Europe's biggest economy.
- Lawmakers voted 364–315 to re-elect Merkel, Germany's leader since 2005, who ran unopposed.
- The coalition of Merkel's conservative Christian Democratic Union, its Bavaria-only sister party, the Christian Social Union and the centre-left Social Democrats has 399 of the 709 seats in parliament.

# Oklahoma To Become first US State To Use Nitrogen Gas For Executions

- Oklahoma plans to start using nitrogen gas for executions, in what would be the first such method of capital punishment in the United States.
- The state is turning to nitrogen after it and other states became unable to acquire drugs required for lethal









- injections because of opposition from manufacturers to their products being used for capital punishment.
- Nitrogen is an odorless and tasteless gas that makes up about 78% of the air humans breathe but causes death when inhaled without any oxygen.
- Oklahoma has not carried out an execution since 2015.

### WHO Member-Countries Commit To End TB By 2030

- Member-countries of the World Health
   Organisation (WHO) South-East Asia Region,
   including India, committed to intensifying efforts
   to eradicate tuberculosis by 2030.
- The summit sets the stage for the September 2018
   United Nations high-level meeting on TB, wherein
   the issue will be discussed at the Heads of State
   level.
- The UN meeting is likely to endorse a set of goals to put the world on course to ending TB.

### **USA launches WTO challenge against China**

 USA launched a challenge at the World Trade Organization (WTO) against China over intellectual property breaches.









- A statement from the US Trade Representative's office, the United States is taking action at WTO to address China's unfair technology practices that run counter to WTO rules.
- US President Donald Trump hit China with tariffs up to 60 billion Dollars of imports to retaliate against the theft of American intellectual property, ratcheting up trade tensions between the world's two largest economies.
- He also announced he was directing the US Trade Representative's office to pursue dispute settlement in the WTO to confront China over its policies that result in unfair treatment for US companies and innovators trying to do business in China.
- US Trade Representative's office in a statement Chinese policies hurt innovators in the United States and worldwide by interfering with the ability of foreign technology holders to set market-based terms in licensing and other technology-related contracts.
- China warned the US that it was not afraid of a trade war as it threatened tariffs on 3 billion dollars worth of US goods in retaliation over the US measures.







 The World Trade Organization is not only a forum for nations to negotiate trade deals, but it also acts as a court to resolve trade disputes.

### Maharashtra gets its very own first ever Mega Food Park in Satara

- Maharashtra got its own 1st ever Mega Food Park in Satara Mega Food Park Pvt. Ltd was inaugurated at Village Degaon in Satara district.
- Minister of Food Processing Industries Harsimrat Kaur Badal unveiled the Satara Mega Food Park in the presence of Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis. Satara Mega Food Park, first in Maharashtra, is the 12th Mega Food Park operationalized in the country so far and the 10th operationalized during the tenure of present government", Ministry of Food Processing Industries Harsimrat Kaur Badal
- The Ministry is focusing on boosting the food processing industry so that agriculture sector grows exponentially and become a major contributor to doubling the farmer's income and 'Make in India' initiative of the government.











# Karnataka To Become 2nd State In Country To Unveil Its Own Flag

- The Karnataka government unveiled the State flag (nada dhwaja) for the state.
- If approved by the Centre, Karnataka will be the second State to have a flag after Jammu and Kashmir.
- The yellow-white-red flag has the State emblem at the center.
- The proposal will be now sent to the Union Home Ministry for approval since a State has no powers to announce its own flag.

### **BHEL Secures Order Worth Rs 736 Crore From NPCIL**

- The public sector Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) secured significant orders worth 736 crores after competitive bidding, for supplying Steam Generators for the Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL).
- The generators will be manufactured at the Tiruchirappalli plant of BHEL and will be installed











at the Pressurized Heavy Water Reactor (PHWR), Gorakhpur, Haryana.

# Home Minister Rajnath Singh Inaugurates Asia-Pacific Regional Conference Of IACP

- Home Minister Rajnath Singh inaugurated the two-day Asia-Pacific Regional Conference of the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) in New Delhi.
- The theme of the conference is "Challenges to Policing in 2020 – How is Cyber Space shaping our approach to Cybercrime and Terrorism, how do we perform within it and take advantage of it".

# IRCTC introduced Billing Through Point Of Sale In Trains

 Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) introduced billing through Point of Sale (POS) hand-held machines in trains to check overcharging by vendors.







- This move will help not only making passengers aware of relevant information but also in improving the passenger satisfaction.
- The POS billing machines will be introduced in trains in a phased manner.
- IRCTC has already introduced POS machines in New Delhi -Karnataka Express on a pilot basis.

### Kerala Declares Jackfruit As Official Fruit Of State

- Jackfruit attained a respected status with the state government declaring it as the official fruit of Kerala.
- Kerala has been producing around 30 to 60 crore jackfruits every year.
- As per the officials, the state can generate a revenue of around Rs 30,000 crore through value-added jackfruit products.

# Chhattisgarh bags 'Water Digest Award' for best water conservation and irrigation facility

 Chhattisgarh bagged the National 'Water Digest Award' for Water Conservation-Diversion and for increasing the irrigation capacity in the State.











- This is the first time that Chhattisgarh Water Resources
   Department had been given national Award during the
   past 17 years.
- The Union Minister of State for Water Resources Arjun Ram Megwal presented the award to Chhattisgarh Water Resources Department Secretary Sonmani Bora.
- The Award is presented every year by the globally renowned magazine 'Water Digest'-which focuses mainly on water resources.
- Chhattisgarh State bagged the award for increasing the irrigation capacity, community participation, water management -water diversion, water conservation, efforts towards inter-linking of rivers, better techniques utilized in irrigation facilities.

## Andhra Pradesh Government Launches Multi-Utility Vehicle 'Naipunya Ratham'

- Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu launched the Naipunya Ratham, a multi-utility vehicle.
- Also known as 'World on Wheels (WoW)',
   Naipunya Ratham is aimed at taking technology
   and innovation to the remote corners of the State.









- As part of the 'Smart Village Smart Ward Programme' of the state, the Naipunya Rathams will facilitate and look to improve digital literacy and digital skills.
- The State Government has allotted Rs 300 crore for the project.

## Ministry of Agriculture and Ministry of Skill Development ink MoU on skill development at KVK

- The Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare and Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship have signed MoU to conduct skill development training programmes for agriculture and allied sector.
- These skill development training programmes will be conducted at Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVKs).
- The MoU will help to increase cooperation between both ministries and help in fulfilling Government's dream of "Kaushal Bharat-Kushal Bharat".
- KVK is a project of ICAR (Indian Council of Agricultural Research) for testing and transfer of Agricultural technologies at the grassroots level.











# Punjab inks MoU with Nandan Nilekani's e-Gov to provide online services

- Punjab government in both transparent and smooth manner, the state government signed a MoU with e-Governance Foundation (e-Gov) of Nandan Nilekani.
- According to the MoU, a total of 67 services would be provided online within a span of 1 year under 12 modules namely Property Tax, Water & Sewerage Management, Complaints and Grievance, Licensing, Fire Service, Verification, Birth and Death, ULB web portal, Mobile App, State and ULB Dashboards, Payroll and Financial Accounting.

- India won the inaugural IBSF Snooker Team World Cup title.
- The Indian combine of Pankaj Advani and Manan Chandra defeated Pakistan in the best-of-five final played in Doha.

## Viswanathan Anand Wins Tal Memorial Rapid Chess Title

- World rapid champion Viswanathan Anand annexed the Tal Memorial rapid chess title in Moscow, Russia after an easy final round draw against Boris Gelfand of Israel.
- His solitary loss came at the hands of Shakhriyar
   Mamedyarov of Azerbaijan in the third round.

## MS Dhoni became Brand Ambassador Of Gaming Platform Dream 11

- Mahendra Singh Dhoni, become a brand ambassador of gaming platform Dream11.
- The former India Test skipper had led the country to a famous triumph in the inaugural World T20 Championship in 2007.













- He would be the new face of the gaming platform's multi-channel marketing campaigns and brand engagement activities.
- Currently, the gaming platform has a user base of 2 crore sports fans playing "fantasy cricket, football, kabaddi, and NBA".

# India win their 6th consecutive T20I against Bangladesh, Nidahas Trophy

 India defeated Bangladesh by six wickets in the second T20I of the Nidahas Trophy in Colombo, to register their sixth consecutive T20I victory and maintain their 100% win record in T20Is against them. India will next face Sri Lanka in the tri-series on March 12. "Man of the Match" awarded to Vijay Shankar.

# Australia Beat England 2-1 To Lift 27th Sultan Azlan Shah Cup

- World champions Australia lifted the coveted Sultan Azlan Shah Hockey title.
- In the final at Ipoh, Malaysia, they beat defending champions England by a narrow 2–1 margin.











Australia won the prestigious tournament for the 10th time.

 Earlier, in the classification match for the 3rd place, Argentina finished third after beating Malaysia 3-2. The hosts ended at the 4th spot.

# Deepa Malik Becomes Asian Rank 1 In Javelin F-53 Category

- Indian para-athlete Deepa Malik won a gold medal in the F-53/54 category javelin event at the World Para Athletics Grand Prix in Dubai.
- With this, she became the Asian rank one in the F-53 category.
- With the win, Deepa has also qualified for the 2018 Asian Para Games in Indonesia scheduled to be held in October 2018.

## Young Shooter Devanshi Rana to participate in Jr World cup at Australia

 The emerging shooter Devanshi Rana will show her talent in the junior shooting World Cup. Jaspal









Rana is the Chief Coach of the Indian Shooting Team, while Subhash Rana will play the role of Technical Officer in the championship.

- The Indian team has been announced for the Junior Shooting World Cup in Australia from March 20 to 29.
- For the first time this year Devanshi Rana, a resident of Dehradun, has been given a place in the Indian team for two tournaments.

PV Sindhu swiftly makes her way in the semi final of All England Championship

- Sindhu come out triumphant and it was particularly pleasing to see how the 22-year-old successfully countered Okuhara's strengths with a more proactive approach despite chasing the match for most of the one hour and 24 minutes duration.
- It was the third straight three-game affair for Sindhu in the tournament.
- With this win, Sindhu, TOISA 2018 Badminton
   Player of the Year, also leveled the head-to-head tally 5-5 against the World No. 6.
- The Indian dominated the net next and then sent one to the back line to grab two match points and then sealed the contest with another precise on-the-line return, much to the delight of the Indian fans.

Purva Barve Won Women's Singles U-19 Title At Israel Junior 2018









- India's Purva Barve won the Women's Singles (Under-19) title at the Israel Junior 2018 Badminton tournament held in Rishon LeZion, Israel.
- She defeated the third-seeded and top-ranked Russian Anastasiia Pustinskaia in three sets.
- The title is her first in 2018 and third overall.
- Earlier she won the Israel Junior 2017, Italian Junior International 2017 apart from a bronze at the Russian Junior White Nights 2017.

# Yuki Bhambri defeated Mirza Basic to cruise into Miami Open tennis second round

- Ace Indian tennis player Yuki Bhambri moved to the second round of Miami Open after beating Bosnia's Mirza Basic 7-5, 6-3.
- The Indian Davis Cupper will now face world number 11 and eighth seed American Jack Sock in the next round.
- This will be the first meeting between the two after 2013 when Bhambri had beaten Sock in a Challenger event.
- He ranked 107 had qualified for the ATP 1000 series main draw with a 7-5, 6-2 win over Sweden's Elias Ymer in the second and final qualifying round.
- He created excellent results against top players as he registered the biggest win of his career, shocked world











number 12 Lucas Pouille in the second round of Indian Wells Masters.

# Elavenil Valarivan Wins Gold In Junior ISSF World Cup Shooting

- Indian shooter Elavenil Valarivan shattered the qualification world record in 10-meter women's air rifle event of the season's first junior ISSF World Cup in Sydney, Australia.
- Besides her individual podium finish, Elavenil also combined with Shreya Agrawal and Zeena Khitta to claim the team gold medal.
- Arjun Babuta bagged his second junior world cup medal, claiming a bronze in men's 10-meter air rifle event.
- The 18-year-old Elavenil, competing in her second World Cup and first final.
- Her 631.4 in the qualification was a new world record.









### Pankaj Advani Wins Asian Billiards Championships Title

- Pankaj Advani defended his Asian Billiards
   Championships title by demolishing his practice partner B Bhaskar 6-1 in the summit clash in Yangon, Myanmar.
- With this win, Advani remains the reigning Indian,
   Asian and world champion in billiards for 2017–18.
- This is Advani's 11th gold medal at the Asian level of cue sports.
- India's Amee Kamani won the Asian Women's Snooker title by blanking her Thai opponent Siripaporn Nuanthakhamjan 3-0.

## PV Sindhu To Be India's Flag-Bearer At 2018 CWG

- Indian Olympic Association (IOA) chooses PV
   Sindhu as the flag-bearer of the Indian contingent
   for the opening ceremony of the Gold Coast
   Commonwealth Games.
- The opening ceremony will be held on April 4.
- She won a silver medal at the Rio Olympics two years ago, the Hyderabad-based World No. 3
