pollution is the introduction of contaminants into the natural environment that cause adverse change. There are different types of pollution like air pollution, water pollution, noise pollution, land pollution. Water pollution is the pollution of bodies of water such as lakes, rivers, sea, the oceans as well as ground water.

Earth is the only planet to have liquid water on its surface. About 71 percentage of earth's surface is water-covered and the oceans hold about 96 percent of all earth's water, only 2.5 percent water we can use for our essential things. The human body must require the nearest 3-litre water every day. Water is one of the very important elements of our life and the environment.

There are many reasons for water pollution. Some of the reasons directly affected on water pollution and some indirectly. Many factories, industries are dumping contaminated water, chemicals, & heavy metals into major waterways as a result of direct water pollution. One more reason for water pollution is the use of modern techniques in farms. Farmers apply nutrients such as phosphorus, nitrogen and potassium in the form of chemical fertilizers, manure, and sludge. It causes farms to discharge large quantities of agricultural organic matter, saline drainage into water bodies, it indirectly affects water pollution.

Water is an important element of human health. Polluted water directly affects the human body. Water pollution causes various diseases like typhoid, cholera, hepatitis, cancer, etc. Water pollution damages the plants and aquatic animals present in the rivers by reducing the oxygen content for the water. Polluted water washes the essential nutrients which plants need out of the soil & also leave large amounts of aluminium in the soil which can be harmful to plants. Wastewater & Sewage is a by-product of daily life & thus produced by each household through various activities like using soap, toilets & detergents. Such sewage contains chemicals & bacteria which are harmful to human life & environmental health. Some time our tradition also becomes a cause for water pollution. Some people throw the statues of deities, flowers, pots & ashes in rivers. While many of the solutions for water pollution need to be applied on a broader macro-level for that individual companies & communities can have a significant and responsible impact on the water quality.
