Right Livelihood Award 2021

The Award was established in **1980** by German-Swedish philanthropist **Jakob von Uexkull** to "honour and support those who offer a practical and exemplary contribution in such fields as environmental protection, human rights, sustainable development, health, education, which are not included in Nobel Prize list.

The Right Livelihood Award comes with a cash prize of **1 million Swedish crowns (\$115,000)** and long-term support to highlight and expand Laureates
