a. Global warming

Global warming is the increase in the average temperature of the earth's atmosphere. It is caused by the rise in carbon dioxide levels in the atmosphere, which leads to an increase in temperature. Global warming has been accelerated due to mass deforestation activities by man. Plants use carbon dioxide to prepare their food and release oxygen as a by-product. So, if we have enough plants, they will absorb the excess carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and decrease the rate of global warming to some extent. Planting more trees can reduce the carbon dioxide levels in the atmosphere and will result in a decrease in global warming.

b. Pollution

Pollution is the addition of unwanted substances into the environment that can damage our Earth. There are 4 main types of Pollution; water pollution, air pollution, soil pollution, and noise pollution. All kinds of Pollution are a result of careless activities by man. We dump waste directly into water bodies, which results in water pollution. Air pollution is caused when vehicles release smoke into the atmosphere and make it difficult to breathe for all organisms. Soil pollution is caused by directly dumping our waste into landfills. Noise pollution is not visible, but it is a dangerous form of Pollution that can damage our ears.

c. Recycle reuse reduce

recycling is the way of converting waste materials/objects into something useful. The main objective of it is to reduce the waste around and also to reduce the widespread pollution. It helps to reduce greenhouse and carbon emissions and therefore control global warming. Recyclates are

the names of those materials sent to the recycling facility for the process. A lot of things at home can easily be recycled into useful products. Used paper, newspapers, and books can be recycled, saving millions of trees. Harvesting rainwater and converting it into potable water is another example.

Recycling involves processing waste into something useful. With the pile of waste on our planet increasing to high levels, the importance of recycling essay is at an all-time high. We need to recycle for a large number of reasons. The main reason is that recycling saves energy and resources and helps reduce greenhouse gases and the years required to decompose waste materials, thereby leaving a better planet for tomorrow.
